# \* Why the Change?

- \* Service Pack 9 was applied August 7 & 8 to optimize start of semester performance
- \* New Course Copy process uses a separate server and queues the content
- \* Helps performance on production server (eLearning)
- \* Improves the copying of large course files/content (no time-outs)

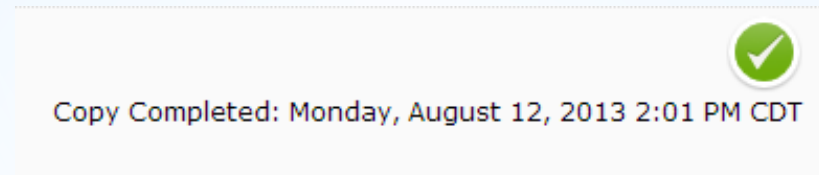

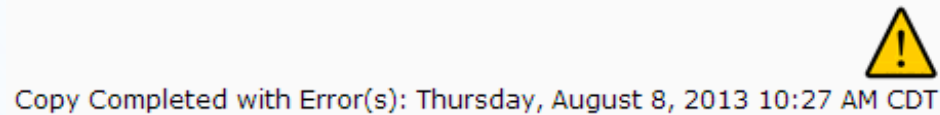
